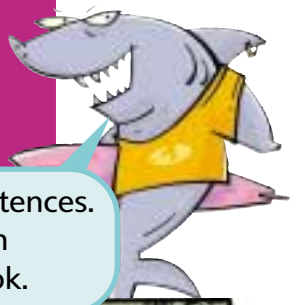


# Danger on the Reef

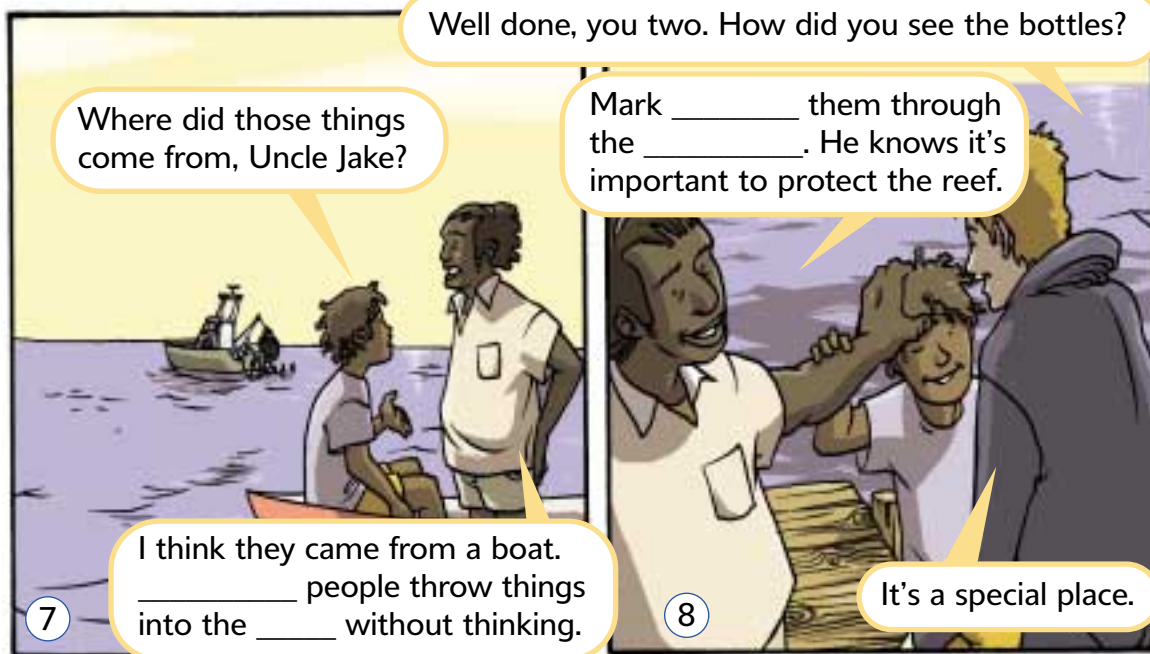


Yes. If we don't do something, they may damage the reef.
